CONVOY OF HOPE

MARK COX, CONVOY OF HOPE

Convoy of Hope is a global, faith-based humanitarian organization dedicated to alleviating poverty and hunger through strategic partnerships and community-focused programs. Since its founding in 1994, Convoy has served more than 250 million people across 130 countries, distributing over \$2.5 billion in relief supplies and mobilizing over 1 million volunteers. In 2024 alone, Convoy responded to 99 disasters worldwide, empowered 61,000 women, trained 39,000 farmers, and fed 639,000 children every school day in 42 countries.

In just the past month, Convoy responded to the devastating tornado outbreak that struck Missouri and Kentucky. In the aftermath, Convoy distributed over 400,000 pounds of essential relief supplies and served more than 22,000 survivors in partnership with local churches. We are excited and looking forward to being with you for a few days this summer at your conference in St. Louis! Please make sure to come up and say hi!
