### CONTEST RULES

Below are the contest rules:

##### **1. Eligibility Requirements:**

- Must be a registered participant of the National Down Syndrome Congress convention in July 2025 in Dallas, Texas.
- Must be able to read.
- Must have an interest in journalism and feel comfortable in front of cameras.

##### **2. How to Participate:**

Interested individuals must send an email to [email address to be defined] stating their desire to participate in the "Journalist for a Day with ION Inclusive Magazine" contest.

The email must include:

- Full name of the participant.
- Age.
- Primary language (English or Spanish).
- Reasons why they want to be a journalist for a day.

### **3. Application Deadline:**

The deadline to submit the application email is **June 30, 2025**.

### **4. Winner Selection:**

- Two winners will be chosen through a raffle among all eligible participants.
- One Spanish-speaking and one English-speaking participant will be selected.
- Winners will be announced on the social media platforms of the National Down Syndrome Congress and ION Inclusive Magazine.

### **5. Training:**

The selected participants will receive **two online training sessions** conducted by the ION Inclusive Magazine team on the following dates:

- **Saturday, July 12, 2025.**
- **Saturday, July 19, 2025.**

### **6. Convention Activity:**

The winners will have the opportunity to be journalists for a day on **Friday afternoon during the convention**, where they will participate in recording interviews and experience being part of the ION Inclusive Magazine team.
