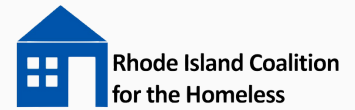

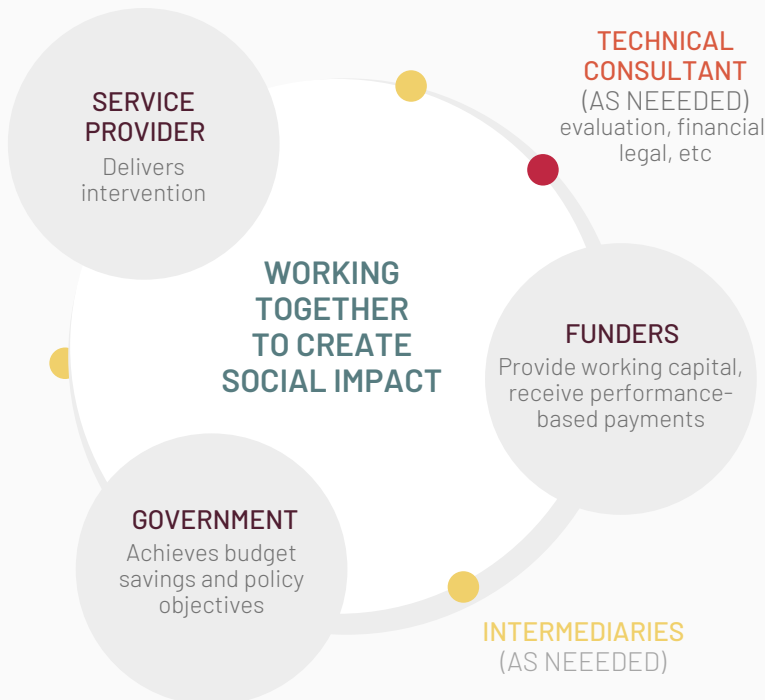

PAY FOR SUCCESS MEETS A SERIOUS NEED AT FAR LESS EXPENSE

High utilization of Medicaid, shelter and correctional systems cost the state \$5.5M to \$7M yearly

Struggling Rhode Islanders are going back and forth between emergency rooms, emergency shelters, and prison. The state government pays \$5.5M to \$7M each year for these costs, without much success. Our neighbors need more than housing: they need wraparound supportive services that provide a path to stability.

Pay for Success will connect Rhode Islanders in need with a voucher for Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH), providing secure housing and supportive services. PSH interventions demonstrate a nearly 90% reduction in shelter days and 50% reduction in days homeless. On any given night, 198 Rhode Islanders experience chronic homelessness. 125 vouchers for Permanent Supportive Housing will provide a real path out of homelessness while saving RI taxpayers \$1.8-\$2.6 million a year.



\$1.8M-\$2.6M in yearly savings

Our state government spends up to \$7M yearly without results. Pay for Success lets us do better: better help our most struggling neighbors and better spend taxpayer funds ending homelessness.



Unlock \$1M in federal funds. Create better and more effective solutions

The project we submitted and the stakeholders we assembled to implement Pay for Success gained national attention and federal funding. 2020 means our last chance to meet HUD's one condition and keep that \$1M RI earned from going to another state.
